




## UPTON COUNTY HORSE PEN RULES

1. Number will be posted on pen. Number will be provided by Upton County Commissioner Precinct 1 in Rankin and Precinct 4 in McCamey.
2. Lock (combination style) will be provided by owner of animal.
3. For the horse and 4-H pens: the number of the pen, number to lock, and contact information will be given to the Commissioner and the County Agent. No horses will be put in 4-H pens for any reason.
4. A waiting list will be made by Commissioner on a first come first serve basis. If an individual wants a pen they must go to the Commissioner and the individual name and contact information will be put on the list.
5. 1 pen per family. For example, if a pen comes available, pen can be taken if individuals name is on the waiting list. Also if there are enough pens to go around it may come back to an individual. An individual can have more pens if every one on the list has a pen. 4-H members will have the right to have more than one pen if the 4-H project is validated through the Texas 4-H Horse Validation Program.
6. If horse pen becomes unoccupied for more than 15 days the pen will go to the next person on the waiting list: unless the occupant of the pen informs Commissioners to explain his or her dilemma and is granted permission to let the pen be unoccupied.
7. Horse stalls must be cleaned out and kept neat. If commissioner has to visit with an individual about getting pen cleaned up the individual will have 15 days to get cleaned up or will forfeit the pen to another person. No alterations of the pens can be made at any time.
8. Horse owners are responsible for the care and feeding of their own animals. Should an issue over care and feeding arise, the Precinct Commissioner and/or County Extension Agent will discuss the problem with the owner. If the situation is not resolved, proper legal action will be taken.
9. No unattended horses inside park area. It is okay to let horses out in arena if all gates are closed. The owner takes full responsibility of the animal.
10. No horses on the air strip in Rankin. No Exceptions.
11. Coggins Papers must be purchased by the owner every year. A copy will be given to the County Agent to be put in file. Every horse owner must have this paper to be in compliance with the Law. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If individual will not comply Texas Animal Health Commission will be contacted and legal action will be taken. This is not our rule, it is **STATE LAW.**
