NOTICE OF INTENT
TO APPLY FOR CLOSURE OF A COUNTY ROAD

Pursuant to Chapter 251 of the Texas Transportation Code, the parties identified below, each being a property owner of land situated in Precinct 2, Upton County, Texas, hereby provide Notice of their Intent to Petition the Commissioners Court of Upton County, Texas, for the closure of an existing public road, specifically Upton County Road 230, from a point described as the start of road from FM 1555 (GPS Coordinates 31°20'50"N 101°49'49"W) to a termination described as approximately 10 miles from 1555 south towards US67 (GPS Coordinates 31°14'11"N 101°51'12"W).

The parties identified below will make application for closure of the identified public road by filing a petition with the Upton County Commissioners Court on the 6th day of April, 2020, at a regular meeting of said Court scheduled for that date. Persons requiring further information should contact the Upton County Judge, Hon. Dusty W. Kilgore, at his office at the Upton County Courthouse, Rankin, Texas, or by calling at (432)693-2321. Interested parties should also plan to attend the Commissioners Court meeting on the date above.
